

**CHEVAL BLANC ST-BARTH ISLE DE FRANCE OPENS ITS DOORS ON
OCTOBER 29TH 2020**

In a few days, Cheval Blanc St-Barth Isle de France will start a new chapter for this 2020/2021 season. La Villa de France, a Caribbean refuge

Cheval Blanc St-Barth Isle de France unveils its exceptional villa : la Villa de France. As a world in itself away from prying eyes, it opens on a larger horizon : 640 sqm with two floors, 5 rooms, 2 infinity edge pools and 2 terraces to contemplate this breathtaking view on the Flamands Bay.

The inside decoration by Jacques Grange is thought for a refuge on the other part of the world, where jungle, corals and ethnographic art complete themselves with charm and give a unique soul to this place where sun and salt bring softness and light ; an warm atmosphere propoer to the welcoming houses by the sea. Everywhere in this vila, there is this peaceful feeling of the movement of the waves and the ocean.

La Case : delicious moments with a brunch by Jean Imbert



La Case is a place anchored in elements : bamboo and wood planted overhang architecture, in front of the ocean. In this back to basics Caribbean philosophy, Jean Imbert composed a cuisine inspired by the nature: savours and colours from Caribbean with the Anguilla tomato, raw fishes like the Mahi Mahi carpaccio with citrus fruits and curcuma, and the delicious Colombo with grilled rice from Saint Martin.

Every Saturdays and Sundays, from 12pm to 6pm, La Case wakes up with the Caribbean rhythm inviting everyone to take time to gather and share a moment with local delicacies by Jean Imbert.

The brunch is refined and gourmand with colored juices, a Kouglof coco with a tropical fruits salad, avocado toasts and Anguilla tomatoes, and the chicken flavoured with herbs from the island, to savour with friends or family.
